Rules of Play

The format is a typical Scramble format: each team member may hit every shot. The team decides which shot it likes best and all players may hit from the location of that shot. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed.

Other rules of play are as follows:

1. USGA stroke rules will govern all competition, with the exception of the use of the Scramble format, and of any local variations.
2. The tournament will be played at scratch with no handicaps.
3. Each member of the team must hit and use a minimum of two (2) tee shots per round.
4. Each team member may place the ball within one club length of the selected shot but no nearer the hole. If a selected shot is played from a hazard, sand trap, rough, second cut of rough, fairway or fringe of the green, again the ball may be placed within one club length of the selected shot, no nearer the hole, and must remain in the hazard, sand trap, rough, second cut of rough, fairway or on the fringe of the green.
5. When putting, you must place your ball within two inches of the selected shot, no nearer the hole. Teams are cautioned not to make tap-ins until all members have had the opportunity to attempt the team's original putt. Once the ball is holed out, no further strokes count.
6. You may stand behind a teammate to help determine the line.
7. You may improve your lie everywhere on the course by placing the ball or by using your club head (remember rules #3 and #4 above).
8. The method of breaking ties will be determined prior to play.
